

#### HOW WE EVALUATE OUR PROJECTS

- Reports from our projects are received quarterly
- They include the number of patients seen
- Qualitative remarks from patients
- Feedback from Staff on the wards
- Level of integration achieved



#### TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL PROJECT

- ✓ Employ the right person!!
- √Qualified and Insured
- √Experienced in therapy
- √Has experience of working with families in distress

- √Works interactively
- ✓ Attends MTD meetings and nursing handovers
- ✓Provides staff treatments
- √Part of the teaching cycle



#### PATHWAY TO A PROJECT VIA SBSHT

- > Healers must have completed our Healing in Hospitals and Hospices training
- > Healer then approaches a centre in their area
- > SBSHT is then contacted by the recruiting centre
- > Once SBSHT have agreed the project we will donate funds into any suitable NHS or related fund
- > The vacancy will be advertised on NHS jobs website or internally if appropriate (SBSHT training as an essential on the PS)
- > The post will be given an NHS fixed term contract



## **DETAILS**

- The Healer must be able to work in an integrated way with patients, relatives and staff and a minimum of 6 patients must be seen per day (30 minute sessions)
- SBSHT has policy, protocols and job descriptions available to govern Reiki / Spiritual Healing if the recruiting centre requires this information
- Similar projects elsewhere are banded 4 or 5 within the Agenda for Change system
- Therapist will wear a SBSHT polo shirt and provide us with quarterly reports
- Projects are for a maximum of 15 hours per week



### SBSHT CAN PROVIDE

- Policy to manage therapy -if none in place
- •Individual protocols to govern individual therapies
- Job descriptions
- •Interview questions
- •Funds

# Costs of a project

- The costs for a Healer for 15 hours a week for a fixed term contract for a year are approximately £12k (this figure covers the salary and any add on costs for the therapist)
- This enables the provision of over 600 treatments at the bedside and elsewhere supporting patients, carers and staff





- We develop and expand our projects by providing funds for a coordinator post if the initial project has been very successful
- Our trustees understand the system from both sides of the track
- This enables us to find our way through the maze of NHS managers and red tape
- It is now 'relatively' easy to place further projects when we have funds available
- We are only 'slowed' in further spread by available funds
